Clayton HOA 2014 Pool Rules

(LIFE GUARDS HAVE FULL AUTHORITY at All Times)

- 1. **Members Only** Clayton Pool Tags are required for entry and must be worn where easily seen at all times when inside the pool gate.
- 2. Children under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult that is at least 18 years of age.
 - a. Supervising adults must monitor their children at all times.
 - b. Plastic pants must be worn over disposable diapers
- 3. Guest must be accompanied by a member at least 18 years of age. Two guests are allowed per tag.
 - a. Guests must arrive and leave with the resident(s) who brought them.
- 4. Please shower prior to entering the pool.
- 5. Proper swim wear required.
 - a. No cut-offs or thong swim wear allowed
 - b. No baggy or loose fitting swim trunks and swim trunks must be lined
- 6. No diving in water (5) feet deep or less.
- 7. Only one person allowed on the slide at a time.
- 8. Three offenses will result in the suspension of pool privileges.
 - a. Once pool privileges have been suspended, the violator (and guardian, if violator is under the age of 18), must address the Board of Directors at a regularly scheduled meeting.
 - b. Board of Directors will determine if violator's pool privileges will be reinstated.
- 9. At the end of each hour, the lifeguards will call a 10-minute adult swim only. No one under the age of 18 is allowed in the pool at that time.
- 10. The following items and activities are strictly prohibited:
 - a. Running, horseplay or diving
 - b. Use of Alcohol or tobacco
 - c. Music or loud noise of any kind
 - d. Foul or offensive language is unacceptable and will not be tolerated
 - e. No lewd or lascivious behavior as determined by the lifeguard
 - f. Hair clips, pins and other objects are harmful to the pool system: please remove before entering the pool.
 - g. The use of glass containers of any kind
 - h. Pets are not allowed in pool area
 - i. Chewing gum is not allowed in pool area
 - j. No one with a communicable disease, excessive sunburn, a cold, nasal or ear discharge, open sores, bandages or eye inflammation will be allowed in the pool.
- 11. Only small flotation devices approved by the lifeguards may be used. No flotation device may be used when using the slide.
 - a. Water guns are not allowed.
- 12. Weather Policy: The lifeguards will close the pool immediately at the first site of lightening or sound of thunder.
 - a. The lifeguards may instruct the pool area to be cleared at their discretion in times of inclement weather.
